

What They Do:

Aquatabs are effervescent tablets which kill micro-organisms, such as giardia cysts, in water to prevent diarrhoeal diseases such as cholera, typhoid, dysentery and other water borne diseases.

How To Use:

Add 1 tablet to 1 litre of clear water. Mix well. Leave for 30 minutes before use. Where there is sediment in the water, allow the water to settle or filter through a fine cloth. The filtered water is then treated.

Ingredients:

Each tablet contains 8.5mg Troclosesene Sodium
